FAFSA Completion Workshop

Available beginning October 1. This "hands-on" in-school or online with Stand by Me's FAFSA experts. Is appropriate for Grade 12. It will provide students and families with actual, real-time assistance in completing the FAFSA. Time: Generally 2 hour workshop. The average FAFSA will take 30-40 minutes to complete.

FAFSA Online Appointments

Beginning October 1. Appropriate for Grade 12. Students/parents can make a free Zoom appointment with a Stand by Me NexGen FAFSA expert. Time: 1 hour

Choose Your Own Path! Post-Secondary Options

This workshop, appropriate for all grades, provides an overview of the various post-secondary options available to students after graduation from high school. Through this presentation, students and parents will be given information, action steps, and resources relating to both educational and work-based paths to career attainment. Time: 30-60 minutes.
